

What have we been learning?

This month we started off by identifying different tracks that some animals had left in the garden, we were excited to learn we had been visited by a fox, pheasant, badger and a robin, which then inspired us to make our own animal tracks.

We then looked at our garden and what we could begin to grow. The children used recycled containers and filled them with leaf mulch and planted lots of seed ready for the spring.

We have also been looking at the different birds that visit our garden and the children have learnt what they might like to eat and made their very own bird feeders that we have hung in the garden.

The children have also learned about what plants need and have been helping to look after our houseplants too.
